



The Janhuis at Zeeveld, Information and Tips A-Z

Arrival and Departure

- Unless otherwise agreed upon, your arrival is possible from 3 PM, and your departure is no later than 11 AM.

Barbecue

- A barbecue is available. Complete barbecue 'packages', various meats, bread, sauces etc. can be bought anywhere, for instance at www.vanderpoel.keurslager.nl.

Beach

- There are (at least) two ways to reach the beach. You can take a lovely walk through the dunes (approximately 40 minutes) or go by bike (20 minutes) and this will take you to a very quiet beach without any beach pavillions or facilities for food or drink. Also, you can take the car to a beach a little further away where you do find all these amenities. In the green book in the entry room you will find maps or look [here](#). Please note that you have to buy dune access tickets at the machine at the carpark. You can buy a week ticket. This is because the dune area is a National Park

Bicycles and cycling

- There is room to store your bikes in the Janhuis garden. There is no indoor storage possibility for 'expensive' bikes; those who are concerned by this are advised to bring an extra lock.
- Bikes of every make and variety can be rented from

Caretaker

Cleaning utensils and materials

- In the laundry room you find lots of cleaning materials. Waste and bin bags are provided as well as kitchen paper, dishwasher tablets, cleaning liquids, hand soap, toilet paper/bathroom tissues and handtowels.

Complaints

- If anything is not as you would have expected it, or if something is broken or there is a malfunction, please contact the caretaker immediately. He will do whatever possible to get things right for you.

Hiking trails

- At fifty meters from The Janhuis - fence out, turn left - at the information board on the corner Noorderstraat, three marked hiking trails begin. They are three, seven and seventeen kilometers long respectively.
- Three easy walks are also the unmarked routes that lead in a ever larger circle around the 'Zeeveld', each time a question of: house out, right, first gate to the right and then again and again 'right' .
 1. You walk around in a minute or 20 'Zeeveld' and get a very different and beautiful view of the house.
 2. You can extend this walk by - see the map in this folder - instead of the path directly adjacent to 'Zeeveld' the westerner Kroftlaan. You have a good view of the dune area. This is a walk of around 30 minutes.
 3. An even longer round trip for a westerner middle part of the walk: the Staringweg. Beautiful view of the bird's square. A round of about 45 minutes.

To take a map is recommended; Or else a phone so you can call if you get lost. Yes, that happens. Also: all the benches in the dunes have numbers so you can easily trace where you are in case you have to call emergency service 112

House manager

- The house manager lives on the site and is available for whatever questions may arise.

Kitchen inventory

- The kitchen inventory includes all imaginary dishes, plates, glasses, serving and coking utilities and also a hand-blender, apple cake form, thermos flask for tea and coffee, a toaster, a six burner stove as well as microwave with oven, a freezer and a ee refrigerator. Also to be found in the kitchen: A Nespresso machine, coffee filters and various basic spices. Please restock after use.

Laundry

- In the laundry room you find a washer and dryer as well as an iron and ironing board.

Linnen 1

- Kitchen linen and bathroom hand-towels are provided. and coffee filters for the coffee machine are also provided.

Linnen 2

- The linen pack contains: mattress, duvet and pillow covers, towel, flannel. Guests staying longer then a few nights are advised to bring an extra towel. For those who want to go to the beach, separate beach towels are also recommended.
